WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

The ICCRS Leadership Training Course is designed to serve people of all ages from charismatic organizations and ministries worldwide who desire to enhance their service in the renewal.

THE PROGRAM

The program will include daily Mass, eucharistic adoration, confession, and times of charismatic praise and worship. The teachings will cover two basic areas: the foundations and vision of the Catholic charismatic renewal (ecclesiology, baptism in the Holy Spirit, history of the renewal, a theology of mission); and practical help and ideas for ministry (elements of a prayer meeting, basic techniques for evangelization, the life of leaders). Our week together will also include time for reflection, sharing, and ministry. Additionally, we may offer a one-day pilgrimage to the original Ark and the Dove Retreat House where the renewal began in 1967, just outside of Pittsburgh.

AN OPPORTUNITY FOR SPECIAL GRACE

The Vatican granted a plenary indulgence to any conference attendee who prays in the Portiuncula Chapel on campus and meets the normal requirements for such an indulgence granted by the Church.

The course begins at 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 12. Registration will be held from 12 Noon to 8:00 p.m. and a travelers' Mass will be available at 4:00 p.m. in Christ the King Chapel. The course concludes at 12 Noon on Sunday, September 19.

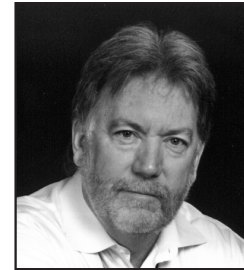
